Renata is a photo-media artist, educator and researcher, who is passionate about physically engaging with nature and organic processes and helping her audiences to reconnect with the natural environment. Her art practice builds on alternative and experimental photography; includes intercultural and art-science research, and interdisciplinary collaborations. Since 2005 she has been working with an image making process she calls the biochrome, which is based on fusion of organic and photographic materials. Renata's recent projects include practice-led research focusing on Australian healing plants significant to the Quandamooka Peoples of Minjerribah/North Stradbroke Island; and an art-science collaboration exploring soil degradation. Her work has been exhibited in solo and group exhibitions nationally and internationally, received a number of art awards, and it is featured in private and public collections.
